

License Fee Only \$100 Increase

On Monday, December 5th, Deputy Commissioner Curtis Thayer told the Legislature's Budget & Audit Committee that the real estate license increase would only be \$100. This would make the two-year license fee \$375 instead of the proposed \$685.

With the 2,450 licensees in the State, this is a \$759,500 savings, \$310 per licensee.

According to Don Haberber, the Director of the Division of Corporations, Business & Professional Licensing, "the change was based on the robust public comment on the fee increase proposal as it came out in draft stage."
