

Act Now on Proposed License Renewal Fee of \$810 – October 24, 2011

The Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing has put out a regulation project that stipulates an increase in the license renewal fees to \$685 from the current level of \$275. The Alaska Association of REALTORS® (AAR) feels that this fee is unwarranted and unsupportable. We ask that you get involved in this important process by responding during the public comment period that ends on October 25, 2011. If this regulation goes through unchecked and if the recovery fund is increased to the proposed level of \$125, the total cost to renew your license will be \$810. **[Click here to listen to Dave Somers explain why we need your help NOW!](#)**
